1. Thank you for your email of 1 May 2025 in which you requested information from UK Anti-Doping ('UKAD') under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'). Specifically, your request was as follows:
 1. *Could you please provide the total financial contributions made by the Football Association to UK Anti-Doping (UKAD) for the financial years 2021/2022, 2022/2023, 2023/2024, and 2024/2025?*
 2. *Could you please provide the total financial contributions made by the Premier League to UK Anti-Doping (UKAD) for the financial years 2021/2022, 2022/2023, 2023/2024, and 2024/2025?*
2. On 29 May 2025, in response to a request from UKAD, you provided the following clarification:

By financial contribution, I am referring to the total amount of money that the Premier League and the Football Association individually provided/sent/contributed to UKAD for the requested financial years. Please could you provide that number for each of the two associations.

5. Please note that the figures contained in Table 1 represent the gross total financial contributions made by The Football Association (The 'FA') and are inclusive of Value Added Tax ('VAT').
